Homeowners and Property Owners – Electrical Safety

The electrical wiring of permanent electrical installations for residential homes, commercial buildings and industrial facilities is recommended to be periodically inspected at periods not exceeding five (5) years to determine if the installation is safe.

Further, if the electrical wiring of the above buildings has been modified from the original installation that was inspected, an electrical inspection of these modifications must be carried out to determine if the overall electrical installation is safe.

To get an updated Electrical Certificate of Approval for an electrical installation, homeowners and property owners can apply to the Electrical Inspectorate Division for a “Condition Inspection”.
