## Introducing... Residential Electrification Assistance Programme (REAP)

Access to electricity is one of the main drivers of sustained economic development, and for improving the quality of life of the people in all communities. Despite considerable investment in electrification programmes over the years, there are still serious deficiencies in persons accessing this basic infrastructure. Homeowners complain of their inability to afford the wiring/rewiring of their homes especially in rural communities throughout the country.

This Programme seeks to accelerate residential access to an adequate supply of electricity in a safe and reliable manner by:

Assisting home owners in the wiring and rewiring of homes.

## REAP

The Programme will comprise of:

First-Time Wiring / Rewiring – will offer one-time assistance to eligible persons whose homes have never been wired or where the existing electrical wiring is old and faulty, and may pose severe fire risks, or may not meet the approved electrical standards.



## General Programme Criteria

- Applicants with a total household income of less than \$6,000.00 per month;
- Pensioners inclusive of Social Welfare Beneficiaries (Old Age Pensioners or recipients of Disability Grants, or Public Assistance);
- Applicants who suffer from a disability;
- Persons affected by fire or natural disaster.
