All Electric Fences shall comply with the following:

- 1) I.E.C. 60335-2-76 Edition 2.2 2013-05 International Electrotechnical Commission: Household and similar electrical appliances Safety Part 2-76: Particular requirements for electric fence energizers
- 2) TTS 171: Part 1: 2002 Including Amendment 1 (2007)- Trinidad and Tobago Electrical Wiring Code Part 1 Low Voltage Installations
- 3) other requirements of the Electrical Inspectorate Division.

Further, all new Electric Fences must be inspected by the Electrical Inspectorate Division and a certificate of approval given before energizing the fence.
