Charting the way forward for the Postal Sector



The Minister of Public Utilities, the Honourable Ancil Antoine Brigadier General (Ret'd), attended the 3rd Caribbean Postal Union Council of Ministers of Postal Affairs Conference in Bridgetown, Barbados on July 01, 2016. Ministers from Barbados, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Saint Lucia, and Turks and Caicos were also in attendance.

The one-day meeting provided a unique opportunity for Minister Antoine to meet with his regional counterparts to discuss major postal-related issues, and to chart the way forward for the postal sector as it responds to the challenges of electronic substitution, increased competition and changing consumer behaviour.

At the 19th Caribbean Postal Union (CPU) Conference also held in Barbados,

Mr Allan Smith, Post Master General for Bermuda, was elected to the position of Secretary General of the CPU; while Mr. Reynold Baldeosingh, Managing Director of TTPost Trinidad and Tobago, was nominated to serve on the Management Board of the CPU.

Trinidad and Tobago's participation at this conference and continued engagement with the CPU will ensure that TTPost keeps up with international standards of mail delivery, thus supporting Government's mandate to provide high quality Postal Services to its citizenry. Already, the Corporation has achieved 93% door-to-door delivery. The Ministry of Public Utilities remains committed to helping the Postal Sector achieve even greater efficiency as it seeks to serve the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.
