REGISTRATION OF SERVICE PROVIDERS (LICENSED ELECTRICIANS)

The Ministry of Public Utilities is seeking Licensed Electricians to be part of a pool of house-wiring contractors to carry out house-wiring projects in low income households in **Trinidad and Tobago**.

TARGET GROUP: Licensed Electricians, Sole Traders and Registered Companies.

- II. Completed Registration forms must be accompanied by photocopies of the following documents:
 - Valid Wireman's License
 - A valid form of National Identification of person(s) authorized to conduct business
 - Certificate of Good Character of Licensed Electrician (no more than 6 months old)
 - Curriculum Vitae including work experience
 - Letter of Recommendation

For registered companies, the following additional information is required:

- VAT Certificate of Registration
 - Certificate of Company Registration or Incorporation
 - Company profile including work experience
- III. Completed registration forms must be enclosed in an envelope clearly marked 'Registration of Service Providers (Licensed Electricians)' and addressed to:
